- **Abstract:** The traditional and cultural peculiarities of Gorontalo culture are widely recognized. What's undeniable is the idea that people habitually conduct certain things and make certain transactions at certain times. Also known as the Gorontalo seasonal phenomena, this phenomenon causes various words such as "wedding season," "planting season," and "Hajatan season" to take place in Gorontalo.
