Aguidelines for Managing the Impact of Tourism Case Study: Ban Nong Lom, Dokkhamtai District, Phayao Province, Thailand.

- Abstract: The objective of this research was to study tourism management and explore guidelines to manage the impact of tourism case study: Ban Nong Lom, Dokkhamtai District, Phayao Province, Thailand. Key sources of information were from the government sector and the community sector, including those who are directly involved in the tourism sector as well as those in the community sector who are not concerned with tourism. Cases were selected using a purposive sampling technique. Secondary data was collected from documentary sources: textbooks, journals, articles, related research, primary data collected from the survey, interviews, and brainstorming sessions for options on the impact of tourism management.
